Event Terms and Conditions

I declare that:

- To the best of my knowledge, all persons named in the event booking are physically fit to take part in the event.
- If the booking includes children aged under 16, at least one person named in the event booking is over 18 years old.

I understand that:

- Event participants take full responsibility for any loss, accident, injury, damage, cost or any other adverse consequence of participating in the event. If the participant is under 16 years old, such responsibility rests with the adult (aged 18 or over) member(s) of the group named in the event booking.
- Adult members of the group are responsible at all times for supervising the behaviour of under 16s in their group to ensure that they do not endanger themselves, other cyclists, or anybody else.
- It follows from the above that the event organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, accident, injury, damage, or cost that may arise as a result of participating in this event.

- The event organisers will try to ensure that the event starts at the advertised time.
- Cyclists must arrive at the meeting point at least 30 minutes before the start time to ensure that the event can start promptly.
- People who arrive within 30 minutes of the start time may not be allowed to join the event if their late arrival would delay the start of the event.
- When the maximum number of entrants has been reached, nobody else will be allowed to join the event.

- Cyclists will wear a cycle helmet that meets UK safety standards.
- Cyclists will comply with all instructions given to them by the organisers.
- For safety reasons, cyclists must not leave the event route set out by the organisers.
- Similarly, cyclists must check back in at the end of the event so that the organisers can be sure that everybody has completed the course safely.

- In exceptional circumstances, eg extreme weather, we may have to cancel the event. This decision will be made by 6pm the evening before. We will post a cancellation notice on the website and notify all entrants who have booked. If the event is cancelled, refunds will be made on request.

- If people who have booked are unable to attend the event, the cost will be refunded if they cancel by the date stated on the website.
