3. Welcome and introductions

Al Dargie welcomed everyone to the meeting.

4. Declarations of interest - none

5. Minutes of September meeting

Kathleen Cameron proposed acceptance of the minutes, seconded by Beth Hay.

6. Matters arising from September meeting

Al Dargie said that feedback had been provided on the proposed Glenmore traffic regulations.

7. Treasurer's report

Beth Hay said that there were still problems with traffic speed in and out of the north end of Aviemore.

9. Business

a. Election of Secretary

Al Dargie said that Elspeth Byrne had tendered her resignation as Secretary. He thanked her for the work she had done for AVCC.

Al Dargie called for nominations for Secretary. Kathleen Cameron nominated Al Dargie as Secretary, seconded by Jeni Pacitti.

b. Community Council elections – position of AVCC and any interim actions required

Al Dargie said that the nominations had been published on Wednesday 4th October. As there were only 6 people this was an uncontested election. He said that AVCC would go into dissolution at 12am on Tuesday 10th October.

Al Dargie proposed that the inaugural meeting be held on Thursday 9th November, the 2nd Thursday in the month as per our previous schedule. Seconded by Elspeth Byrne.

The proposed asset transfer to AGCT creates risk to visitor experience, eg with toilet facilities etc. FLS can't sign a new lease until they know the outcome of the proposed asset transfer. If the proposed asset transfer is not concluded quickly there is a risk to visitor services next summer.

Al said work has been completed on the toilets at Glenmore. The underpass from the Pine Martin Bar to the toilets will be sorted out next year.
